

Tustumena To Be All-America Special

The state ferry Tustumena will become an "All-America Special" the last weekend in April. The vessel, according to Traffic Manager William Morrice, will operate a special round-trip between two of Alaska's three "All America City" designees.

Start of the voyage will be at midnight from Seward, April 29, following ceremonies at this Resurrection Bay city.

The Tustumena will proceed to Valdez, arriving about 10 a.m. on Saturday, April 30, where additional ceremonies will take place. The ship will depart at midnight, arriving back in Seward at 10 a.m. May 1. From there it will resume its published sailing schedule.

Regular rates will apply during the trip.

Because the vessel will not operate into Anchorage until later in the month, the ship will not participate in the All-America City ceremonies honoring that city.
