

Pt. Hope Girl to Accompany Leading Scientists on an Expedition

A Point Hope student has been selected for a scholarship which will enable her to accompany some of the nations leading scientists on an expedition into Oregon's wilderness according to Senator Ted Stevens (R-Alaska).

Maud Oktolik will travel from Point Hope to Portland, Oregon to join three other students on the ecology expedition which is sponsored by the Bureau of Indian Affairs.

The expedition was arranged through the Explorers Club and

Education Expeditions International in cooperation with the Smithsonian Institution.

Stevens said the selection of the students was based upon demonstrated interest and achievement in the natural sciences.
