

F&WS names boss for regional job

Richard Randall has been named regional supervisor of the Alaska Department of Fish and Game's Arctic-Yukon-Kuskokwim commercial fisheries program.

He will be responsible for directing the management and research programs of the commercial and subsistence salmon, herring and crab fisheries in the Kuskokwim, Yukon, Norton Sound, and Kotzebue areas, with field offices located in Bethel, Emmonik, Nome, Kotzebue and Fairbanks.

According to former Commissioner Don Collinsworth, Randall brings with him an extensive background in fisheries management. He worked seven years in the Bristol Bay Area as an area management biologist, and more recently spent six years in Cordova as the Prince William Sound Area management biologist for the Division of Commercial Fisheries.
