ty appointments and all courses meet at least minimum UAF standards. It is called the North Slope Higher Education Center, because, at present, it does not have independent status as an accredited institution of higher education. As a goal, the NSHEC will maintain such an affiliate accreditation relationship until some point in the future, when it will seek its own independent accreditation.

The Director reports to a Board of Directors, comprised of seven members, who are nominated by the communities located within the Borough's 88,000 square mile jurisdiction and confirmed by the Borough Assembly.

Duties and Responsibilities:

As the leader of the NSHEC, the Director must possess a high degree of professional competence, coupled with authentic sensitivity to the shifting needs and demands of a non-traditional educational institution. The Director needs to exhibit considerable cross-disciplinary skill and expertise in order to refine and foster an organization that operates with academic integrity and cultural respect. The Director is responsible for:

1. The overall functioning of the NSHEC, by demonstrating leadership and expertise in the academic, administrative, and fiscal spheres;
2. Maintaining a culturally-sensitive climate supportive of teaching, learning, student development, scholarship, research, and service;
3. Providing open and effective channels of communication among the departments and faculty within the NSHEC, as well as with the institutions, organizations, and individuals that comprise its clientele;
4. Serves as the major liaison with the University of Alaska-Fairbanks;
5. The preparation, implementation, and evaluation of the Center's budget and fiscal policies;
6. Recruitment, appointment, evaluation, promotion, and termination of all NSHEC personnel;
7. Articulating the policies, needs, and accomplishments of the NSHEC to the larger university structures, as well as the internal/external public; and
8. Teaching at least one course per semester within his/her field of specialization.

1. An earned doctorate in an appropriate field of study;
2. Demonstrated commitment to and understanding of higher education within a non-traditional education setting;
3. Demonstrated commitment to local community control and direction of educational programming within non-traditional settings;
4. Extensive knowledge of educational theories, trends, ideas, and resources, especially as they apply to non-traditional Native American, rural, and for field-based programs;
5. Solid understanding of and demonstrated commitment of the maintenance of Native American values, traditions, and institutions;
6. Commitment to and understanding of the centrality of teaching and scholarship within a community context;
7. Commitment to student growth and development and the demonstrated ability to recognize special student needs;
8. Extensive knowledge of fund-raising, grant-writing, and educational development activities;
9. Excellent communication skills in both formal and informal settings;
10. Demonstrated competence in management of fiscal affairs;
11. Well-developed interpersonal skills and acute sensitivities required to relate to diverse publics;
12. Personal style characterized by integrity, flexibility, and honesty;
13. Extensive college teaching experience;
14. Extensive experience in distance delivery of courses and programs.

Preferred Qualifications

1. Bilingual (English/Inupiaq);
2. Extensive knowledge of the geographic, climatic, and political conditions of the North Slope of Alaska, or other Arctic areas;
3. Experience in Native American, multi-cultural, or bi-cultural situations.
