

File tracers for missing mail

Postal customers who suspect they had mail in the van lost in a Nov. 23 storm on the Gulf of Alaska should contact mailers of the parcels for the initiation of tracers and claims, according to Postal Service officials.

Although post offices in the affected areas with ZIP Code prefixes 995 and 996 (excluding the City of Anchorage)

will accept tracer forms, those, in turn, will be forwarded to the post office where the parcels were mailed, they said.

The officials recommend that all tracers be filed by the mailer so the most accurate information will be obtained.
