Three Native Villages Get HUD Grants

Three Alaskan Native villages have received grants from the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) under the BIA special low-cost housing program, U.S. Sen. Ted Stevens announced today.

All three grants go to the Tanana Chiefs Regional Housing Authority.

One of \$1,172,000 will go to building 40 family units in Ft. Yukon.

The second of \$945,000 is for 30 family units in Galena. Another of \$435,000 will build 15 family units at Tanacross.
