

John Borbridge of T-H Council Asked to Resign

SITKA—A petition demanding resignation of John Borbridge as president of the Tlingit and Haida Indian quasi-municipal corporation has been filed in the State Superior Court by William L. Paul Sr. "upon the relation of the Tlingit Haida Indians of Ala-

ska."

According to the petition, Borbridge claimed qualification as a delegate to the 1969 Tlingit Haida convention by virtue of residency in Juneau.

Paul maintains that at the time and since then Borbridge has been an Anchorage resident and that his election as president is invalid. He has been asked to resign and pay costs.

The suit was filed June 10 by Paul who gave his own residency as Seattle, Washington.
