The North Pacific Rim is currently recruiting for the positions of Comprehensive Community Planner and Community Program Planner. Both positions are funded under a 12-month grant from the administration for Native Americans.

Both positions are based in Anchorage and require frequent travel throughout the Chugach region.

The Comprehensive Community Planner will focus on utilization of community survey data in the development of resource use plans for each of the villages in the region. This may include development of village codes and ordinances, a village land use plan, and village resource use plans, as well as specific implementation of policies and guidelines. Applicants should have a thorough knowledge of and commensurate education in land use or community planning. Pay Range: \$25,000-\$30,000.

The Community Program Planner will provide a hands-on approach for specialized assistance in response to specific requests such as aid in preparing CDBG and RDA grant applications. This strategy will also be used to develop com-
