

# Scientist to Study Eskimo's Move to Alaska

Prof. Michael Nowak of Colorado College is planning an archeological expedition to Nunivak Island this summer in an effort to study the movement of Eskimos to Alaska.

The expedition is a pilot project, to locate sites for future excavations. He hopes to find what kind of Eskimos first lived on the island, and when they arrived.

"There is some indication

that they may have lived on the island for at least two thousand years," he said. "If this is so, we should find physical evidence to support it."

"Also, we would like to find out what kinds of Eskimos first lived on the tundra

covered island and something about the changes that have occurred there over the years."

Nowak will be accompanied by Prof. Don E. Dumon, University of Oregon, and by Mrs. Lynda Nowak, who will be field assistant.
