INVITATION TO BID CHEVAK SCHOOL MODIFICATION FOR INDIAN OWNED AND CONTROLLED ECONOMIC ENTERPRISES

The Kashunamit School District will be accepting sealed bids for Modification of the K-12 School Facility located at Chevav, Alaska.

Sealed bids will be received from qualified Indian-owned firms by the Kashunamit School District at the office of their Architect, Alaska Native Architectural and Engineering Company, 821 "N" Street, Suite 208, Anchorage, Alaska 99501 until 10:00 a.m., April 30, 1986.

The work involved is set aside for bona-fide Indian-owned economic enterprises which are at least 51% American Indian/Alaska Native-owned and controlled. The construction plans and specifications bid package will be sent to any and all firms requesting them. Sealed bids will be accepted from any and all firms wishing to bid on the project. Only sealed bids from Indian-owned firms which are on the State of Alaska Department of Education pre-qualified preference list, or sealed bids from Indian-owned firms which have attached a completed B.I.A. approved pre-qualification questionnaire, will be opened and read aloud. Bids received from non-Indian firms will only be opened if a reasonable bid price is not obtained from an Indian-owned firm. Approximate construction costs: \$1.0 million.

The scope of work includes performing work for conversion of the facility from open classroom concept to a partitioned classroom concept. Work also includes associated mechanical/electrical modifications, code upgrade, and repairs. A pre-bid conference will be held at the Architect's office on April 16, 1986 at 10:00 a.m.

A bid bond in the amount of five percent (5%) of the bid must accompany the sealed bids. The successful Contractor will be required to furnish performance and payment bonds in the amount of 100% of the contract sum.

Bidding packages will be available from the office of the Architect after April 7, 1986.
