Mac Davis has resigned his position of Program Specialist to become Director of the AFN, Inc. Technical Assistance Program.

In addition to his new administrative duties, Davis will continue to work with Regional Corporations, Village Corporations, Native Contractors and Native Entrepreneurs with loan packaging, feasibility studies, seeking needed funding, consumating contracts and grant writing.
