

# Remarried Widows May Get Benefits

"Widows past 60 who have remarried may now be able to get benefits based on their former husband's record," advises Lee R. Christensen, district manager of the Juneau Social Security Office.

He said changes in the Social Security Law now make it possible to pay benefits to remarried widows and women 62 or over who were divorced after at least 20 years of marriage, provided they meet the other requirements for benefits.

"Until this time we couldn't pay some widow's or wife's benefits," Christensen said. "and these benefits are first payable for this September. An application must be filed.

Christensen said applications and information can be obtained by writing Social Security Administration, Box 1331, Juneau.
