This project will consist of grading and drainage of 1.75 miles of roadway.

Principal items of work consist of the following: 110 hours of crawler tractor rental; 110 hours of front end loader rental; 20 hours of petrol grader rental; 440 hours of end dump truck rental; and 130 linear feet of 24 inch corrugated pipe conduit.

**NOTICE OF PROPOSED CHANGES
IN THE REGULATIONS OF THE
DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL
RESOURCES**

Notice is hereby given that the Department of Natural Resources, under authority vested by AS 38.05.020, proposes to amend regulations in Title II of the Alaska Administrative Code to implement AS 38.05.150, as follows:

(1) 11 AAC 84.105(a) is amended to delete the reference to school and mental health lands. A review of AS 159 is being conducted to determine its effects on leasing of school, university, and mental health trust lands.

(2) 11 AAC 84.120(b) is amended to require that coal prospecting permit extension applications be filed no later than 30 days prior to the date on which the permit expires.

(3) 11 AAC 84.120(c) is amended to require that an application for extension must be accompanied by an affidavit substantiating that the applicant has performed 500 feet of aggregate core hole footage or expended \$25,000.00 as defined in this section. An appropriate consumer price index multiplier is determined and comments are solicited.

(4) 11 AAC 84.125 is amended on permit royalty. The prospecting permit must still state the amount of royalty to apply under any lease that supercedes the permit. The changes in this section and in 11 AAC 13.01 are being made no longer being allowed under a prospecting permit.

(5) 11 AAC 84.130 (b) is deleted in its entirety thus eliminating the provision for conversion of a prospecting permit to a lease based on the amount of coal mined.

(6) 11 AAC 84.130 is further amended to define the terms "commercial quantities" and "satisfactory mining plan."

(7) 11 AAC 84.145 is being amended. Regulations for lease royalties and rentals are being revised. A percentage royalty is under consideration utilizing the legally required cents-per-ton as the minimum royalty. Annual lease rentals and the number of years affected is changed.

(8) 11 AAC 84.155 is amended to require the minimum lease bond to be not less than ten thousand dollars and to authorize the director to increase the bond under certain stated circumstances.

(9) 11 AAC 84.160 is amended to state that if failure to comply with the provisions of the lease and/or regulations shall constitute cause for termination of the lease by the director, the lease will terminate.

In addition, the Department of Natural Resources proposes to adopt regulations in Title II of the Alaska Administrative Code to implement AS 38.05.150.

11 AAC 52 is repealed and readopted as 11 AAC 55, with amendments to delete the utility land classification and add three new classifications: greenbelt land, wildlife habitat land, and resource assessment land; and a temporary classification applied automatically to land upon state receipt of title or if conveyed under 48 USC 353, 48 USC 354, or P.L. 830. Other amendments clarify the definitions of the remaining classifications, delineate permitted uses, outline the land use planning requirements for classification, and set out the procedure for public involvement and notification.
