3rd edition of place names book available

The third edition of Alaska Place Names, the standard reference on new and revised place names for the state, is now available from The Denali Press.

The paperback volume represents a 20-year compilation of all decisions on Alaska rendered by the United States Board on Geographic Names from January 1966 through December 1985.

The third edition of Alaska Place Names, nearly double the size of the second edition, provides the most up-to-date coverage and includes about 1,100 Alaska place names. It supercedes earlier editions published in 1974 and 1980.

Included in the third edition are new names, new names representing a change in an earlier decision or historical reference, previously established names with revised descriptions and references from previous decisions and variant spellings to the approved name.

A new feature of the third edition is an index to personal names, corporate bodies, vessels and other significant information contained in the body of each entry.

The book is written by Alan Edward Schorr. He is the author of seven reference books and more than 200 articles, essays and reviews which have appeared in many publications.
