

Sealaska board election to be held

Sealaska shareholders will vote to fill six board of director positions from a slate of 10 candidates when Sealaska's annual shareholders meeting is held in Sitka on June 4.

The meeting was to start early on Thursday at the Sheldon Jackson Junior College.

Shareholders also were sche-

duled to get an overview of corporate activities.

Candidates seeking office include:

-Jim Edenso from Juneau is working for the consulting firm of Earl R. Combs, Inc. as vice-president. His past experience includes Special Assistant to the Governor. Edenso was also on the Board of Trustees of Trans Alaska Oil Pipeline Fund.

-John Borbridge, former chairman and president of Sealaska. He was also president of the Tlingit and Haida Central Council. He is writing a book about Alaska Native Land Claims Settlement Act.

-Eddie Pat Churchill who lives in Wrangell is a fisherman. Churchill also formerly served on THCC and he's Wrangell's former mayor. Churchill is also vice-president of Alaska Aquaculture.

-Mark Jacobs, Jr. is from Sit-

ka and works in general construction. He's a former Sealaska director and is a member of the THCC Executive Committee and the Alaska Native Brotherhood.

Those seeking re-election include:

Judson Brown from Seattle, is a retired longshoreman. He is a former chairman of Sealaska.

-Ray Demmert lives in Ket-chikan and works with a construction firm. He's also a member of Sealaska's Alaska Brick Co.

-Sam Demmert lives in Yakutat and is on a fisheries committee.

-Murlin Everson is from Juneau and is vice-president of operations of the Gold Belt Shareholders Committee.

-Gil Gunderson is from Juneau and works as a fisherman. He's also on Ocean Beauty Seafoods board of directors.

-Roger Lang lives in Anchorage and he works with the Alaska Native Foundation.
