

Library of Cong. Showcase for Centennial

WASHINGTON—Senator E.L. (Bob) Bartlett announced that the Library of Congress in Washington will prepare a special showcase in connection with the Alaska Centennial Celebration.

Senator Bartlett said the exhibition would feature manuscripts, maps, rare books and photographs.

A list of specific items to be included in the exhibit and the dates the collection will be open to the public will be announced later, the Senator said.

Bartlett said the display at the Library of Congress and the traveling exhibit being prepared by the Smithsonian Institution would provide valuable publicity about Alaska and the Centennial Celebration.
