

Minto, Noorvik, Lower Kalskag To Get Portable Sawmills

Recently, Senator Bartlett announced that three portable sawmills had been released by the Bureau of Indian Affairs to be made available to unnamed villages, each valued at about \$38,000.

Area Director Owen D. Morken of the BIA office at Juneau has advised Senator Bartlett that the sawmills, American #1 portables with 100 horsepower diesel power units, will be sent to Minto, Noorvik and Lower Kalskag.

Morken stated that the total

cost of each unit, complete with power unit, transportation and costs of installation and instruction in their use is \$9,224.70.
