

Indian Education Conference

Mr. Eben Hopson, executive director of the Alaska Federation of Natives, was invited to the Second Indian Education Conference in Minneapolis, Minnesota.

The conference was conducted by the University of Minnesota through the Department of Conferences and Institutes of the General Extension Division and the Minnesota Indian Education Committee. It took place August 26-28, 1970.

The National Education Conference has been planned by Indians for Indians. Because Indian cultures and values emerged last year as a dominant concern, these have been designated as the conference theme and will be stressed in the various workshops.

Mr. Hopson was asked to present a paper on "Theories and Ideas on Indian Education."

Because of AFN business, Mr. Hopson was unable to attend and Mrs. Juanita Corwin, his assistant attended the conference in his place, submitting the paper.
