Barrow Hunters Safe After 10-day Ordeal

Two Eskimo hunters of Barrow turned up Sunday in good condition at a Dewline station about 90 miles east of Barrow after they had been reported missing nearly 10 days earlier.

Marchie Nogeak and Artie Ichogak said they survided by shooting and eating seagulls and a seal. They began their hunt in the Arctic Ocean in a 14-foot boat Aug. 20.

According to an Associated Press story, the hunters said theywere trapped in drifting ice and were carried an estimated 60 miles off shore.
