

Entries for Baby Contest

So far the Native Baby Contest of the World Eskimo Olympics of 1970 has received two contestants, one from Mt. Edgecumbe and one from Chistochina.

The first applicant was the 7-month old baby of Mr. and Mrs. Roy Snyder formerly of Nome and who now reside at Mt. Edgecumbe near Sitka.

"Our child, at the time of the event, July 31-August 1, will be 8 months old," said Mrs. Charlotte Snyder.

The other baby is Donna Louise Boston, 9 months old, and she is the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Boston of Chistochina. Her mother is Mrs. Lillian Boston.

In order to qualify, native babies must be one year old or under.

The baby contest is a new category in the Olympics and it promises to be one of the most charming events in the native program.
