The logs would be processed for sale to Japan and local builders.


The report urged an easing of timber sale regulations so that small operators could participate in development more easily.

## Tlingit-Haida Tribal Roll Deadline June 30

Tlingits and Haidas were urged this week by their Central Council president, John Borbridge Jr. to register on tribal rolls by June 30 so they can share in forthcoming judgment funds.

"The \$16,000,000 advanced by the trial commissioner is not the final sum," Borbridge, said. "Our Tlingit and Haida people should not indicate their displeasure with this sum by refusing to enroll. Protect your rights and those of your children by enrolling today."

Applications may be requested by mail from John Hope, Enrollment Office, Bureau of Indian Affairs Box 3-8000, Juneau.

They need include only information about parents instead of a complete family tree if the applicant or his parents were legal residents of Alaska before June 19, 1935.


Birth certificates, rather than birth cards should be included.
