Each bidder shall submit a completed FMBE Certification Form 25A320 3/82, before award. Failure to submit Form 25A320 will disqualify the bidder.

Where percentage goals are specified for a project, bidders must submit a completed Female and Minority Business Enterprise Report, Form 25A326 3/82, attached to the proposal. Proposals will not be considered without a completed Form 25A326 attached. Form 25A326 will be included with the bidding documents."

Bidders that submit false information or that fail to meet Female and Minority Enterprise Goals and fail to demonstrate sufficient reasonable efforts shall not be eligible to be awarded the contract.
