SCIENCE AND CANCER

Free copies of a new edition of Science and Cancer, explaining the nature of neoplastic disease and the efforts of science and medicine to control it, are available from the HEW National Cancer Institute.

The 145-page paperback by Dr. Michael B. Shimkin, an outstanding American oncologist, is written at the high school science level. It was first published in 1964 and was revised in 1969.

The need for another revision is an indication of the accelerating pace of developments in biomedical research. Cancer causes and cures are a prime target for this research.

More than 100,000 copies of the book have been distributed since it first appeared.

Dr. Shimkin served in the U.S. Public Health Service from 1938 to 1963, He was professor of Medicine at Temple University of Medicine for six years and is

now Professor of Community Medicine and Oncology at the University of California at San Diego.

From 1955 to 1960 he was Scientific Editor of the Journal of the National Cancer Institute, and from 1964 to 1969 was Editor of Cancer Research.
