At least that's how Gordon Jackson, Alaska Federation of Natives vice president for Human Resources, feels about two airlines companies which serve rural communities of the state but hesitate to consider giving safety in-structions to passengers in lan-

guages other than English.

After waiting over a month for replies to a request by the AFN Human Resources Committee that Wien Air Alaska and Alas-Airlines provide rural Alaska flight announcements in Native languages, Jackson says he can't understand how they could refuse

"We're talking about saving lives and they're saying they can't," he said. "Alaska Airlines says they will consider a special welcome but I expected a res-




