

BIA Course

A training course that will qualify successful graduates for Civil Service positions throughout Alaska as weather observers is being offered by the Environmental Science Services Administration and the Bureau of Indian Affairs.

Native people who are high school graduates are eligible for the 12 week course to be offered in Anchorage beginning March 1, 1968. Those wishing to attend should have some background in mathematics and science.

Students who complete the course and pass the civil service entrance tests will be hired by the weather bureau for work in Alaska.
