Equal Employment Man to Be in State

The Equal Employment Opportunity Committee of the Anchorage Federal Executive Association this week announced the impending visit of a top executive of the Office of Federal Contract Compliance, U. S. Department of Labor.

Here to explore the proposal, recently advanced by Senator Bob Bartlett for an Area Coordinator for the State of Alaska, will be the Assistant Director for Construction, OFCC, Vincent G. Macaluso.

Mr. Macaluso will be meeting with contractors, labor organizations, and minority group representatives to review the problems and needs generated as a result of the President's Executive Order requiring affirmative action to obtain equal employment opportunity in Federal and federally—assisted construction contracts.

During the week of February 5, Mr. Macaluso will also visit Fairbanks, Nome, Bethel, and Juneau.

If time permits, he hopes to take trips to several of the villages in Northwest and Southcentral Alaska to gain firsthand knowledge of the unemployment problems of the Alaskan natives, which was brought to the attention of top Federal officials in Washington recently in testimony presented by Senator Bob Bartlett; Bob Arnold, Federal Field Committee; and Willard Bowman, Alaska State Commission for Human Rights.

The EEO Committee's goals are to encourage affirmative action in achieving equal employment as directed by the President's Executive Order.
