

BSFW Terminates Request for Land

Burton W. Silcock, State Director, Bureau of Land Management, announced this week that the Bureau of Sport Fisheries and Wildlife has terminated its withdrawal request for 54.4 acres at Old Chevak.

The withdrawal was to be used as an administrative site in connection with Clarence Rhode National Wildlife Refuge.

After more closely assessing its needs, the BSFW determined that only 10.5 acres are actually needed, and this amount is now protected by a federal right-of-way.
