

CUTTER LINCOLN — Having transported the first U. S. Government agent to the newly-acquired Alaska Territory at Sitka in August, 1867, the Revenue Cutter Lincoln continued to explore the Alaskan coastline. Upon completion of its assigned tasks, the Cutter Lincoln headed south in the fall of 1870, and was photo-

graphed at anchor near Victoria, British Columbia. The Revenue Cutter Service was the forerunner of the U. S. Coast Guard which is celebrating its 182nd Anniversary, and the 105th year of service to Alaskans.

3,700 Veterans Placed in Jobs

JUNEAU — More than 3700 veterans were placed in jobs through Alaskan manpower centers in fiscal year 1972, Commissioner Henry A. Benson announced today.

The commissioner paid veteran placements represented 49.5 per cent of all male placements made by the manpower centers from July 1, 1971 through June 30, 1972.

Most of the veteran placements were made in Anchorage, Fairbanks, Juneau and Ketchikan, the population centers of the State. The manpower centers in these cities placed 2903 veterans in jobs.

"Assisting veterans to find employment continues to be the number one priority activity in each of the Labor Department's manpower centers throughout Alaska," Benson stated.

"They are willing and able workers and deserve the opportunity to be part of the economic mainstream now that their military service is completed."

Research Grants for Indians, Chicanos, Etc.

John D. Twiname, Administrator of HEW's Social and Rehabilitation Service, announced today the award of 23 research grants totalling \$2,177,278 for studying the special needs of Asian Americans, Chicanos, Indians, Blacks, Cubans, Puerto Ricans and Gypsies.

The research and demonstration projects — which will be conducted in 16 cities — will cover such areas as drug addiction among Asian women and teenage Chicanos, legal services for delinquent youth, alcoholism among Indians, developing black researchers in the field of rehabilitation, and developing a vocational rehabilitation model for gypsies.


Associate Administrator Richard M. Longmire, SRS program manager for the minorities studies, said that "the overall purpose of the research is to enable minority groups to identify the barriers that prevent eligible members of their groups from receiving social and rehabilitation services and to develop methods for overcoming these barriers."

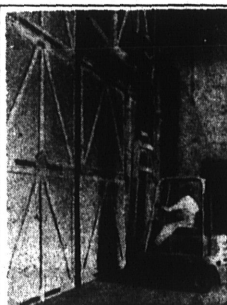
