

3,700 Veterans Placed in Jobs

JUNEAU — More than 3700 veterans were placed in jobs through Alaskan manpower centers in fiscal year 1972, Commissioner Henry A. Benson announced today.

The commissioner said veteran placements represented 49.5 per cent of all male placements made by the manpower centers from July 1, 1971 through June 30, 1972.

Most of the veteran placements were made in Anchorage, Fairbanks, Juneau and Ketchikan, the population centers of the State. The manpower centers in these cities placed 2903 veterans in jobs.

"Assisting veterans to find employment continues to be the number one priority activity in each of the Labor Department's manpower centers throughout Alaska," Benson stated.

"They are willing and able workers and deserve the opportunity to be part of the economic mainstream now that their military service is completed."
