NOTICE OF INTENT TO CONTRACT: Research on Subsistence Use Impacts of the Northwest Alaskan Gas Pipeline Project. The State of Alaska, Department of Natural Resources, Office of the Pipeline Coordinator, hereby publically expresses its intent to contract for work to be performed as described herein.

Purpose of Notice

The purpose of this Notice of Intent to contract is to solicit expressions of interest from qualified furms for the work described herein. NOTE: This is not a request for proposals. Firms are invited to a pre-proposal conference to be held on October 8, 1980 at the Office of the Pipeline Coordinator, Fourth Floor, Suite 450, 1001 Noble Street, Fairbanks, Alaska, at 10:00 AM. Deadline for responses to this Intent should be in the Pipeline Coordinator's Office no later than 4:30 PM October 6, 1980. NOTE: The pre-proposal conference is not mandatory for firms to receive a request for porposals package, or for submission of proposals in response to the RFP.

Form of Expressions of Interest

Responses to this intent must detail the following:

- 1 Name and address of firm
- Principle Officers of firm
- Principle research staff and vitae:
- Length of firm's history in Alaska research and chronology of history;
- Details of firms work within the State including rural, arctic, and sub-arctic experience;
- Examples of relevant work;
- Prior contract references; and 8. Other Information relating to ability to perform work outlined herein.

Description of Work

The project is intended to develop research designs for gathering baseline data on subsistence activities and resources. This data shall be used for identifying possible measures that might be taken by Northwest Alaskan Pipeline Company, to mitigate potential adverse impacts on subsistence users. For the purpose of this project "subsistence user" is defined by AS 16.05.940 (26). The contractor shall include a design for monitoring the effects of the gas pipeline project on subsistence activities

In addition to design, it is intended that preliminary application of the design be performed by gathering of baseline data and the submission of a series of interim reports describing progress of design and preliminary data-gathering; preliminary findings; and a description of subsistence use conflicts requiring mitigation together with recommendations for such mitigative measures as may be required

Key elements in both design and activities are:

- Assessment of subsistence use in relationship to the gas pipeline right-of-way;
 Coordination with current or anticipated biological, resource, social, or economic studies;
- 3. Involvement of local residents, esp. subsistence users in the development and implementation of design
- 4. Publication of Interim Reports including one on conflicts identification and mitigation
- 5. Work review by Subsistence Advisory Board to the Pipeline Coordinator; and
- 6. Interface with appropriate groups, municipalities, Fish and Game Advisory Boards, etc., as needed.
