This project will consist of furnishing and placing approximately 4,132 square feet of standard signs on all secondary highways in the Interior District. ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 74-4D
This is a non-code ordinance appropriating money out of the treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1975. It amends Ordinance No. 74-4B in that the sum of \$2,148,000.00 is appropriated to Education-Foundation Program.

ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 74-4E
This is a non-code ordinance appropriating money out of the treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1975. It amends Ordinances No. 74-4 and 74-4B by appropriating federal revenue sharing monies amounting to \$148,496.00.

ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 74-5A
This is a non-code ordinance amending Ordinance 74-5, the Long Range Capital Improvements Program, as to the start of construction of the Barrow Teachers' Housing, Wainwright, Point Lay and Atkasook Educational facilities. In addition, Section 13, Ordinance 74-5, is amended by authorizing the Barrow Gas and Heat Project in the amount of \$2,000,000.00 funded by General Obligation bonds to be voted upon in October 1965.
