OKLAHOMA Indian students planning on pursuing a career as a health professional will have an opportunity this summer to spend ten days with a practicing American Indian physician, dentist, pharmacist, osteopath, veterinarian, optometrist, or podiatrist.

In addition to living with these Indian health professionals and their families, participating students will accompany the practitioners on their daily routines. This experience-provided as part of the Summer Live-In Program sponsored by the Association of American Indian Physicians (AAIP)-is designed to reinforce the students' decisions to become health professionals by giving them first hand exposure to the Indian physician's family life and daily routine on the job.
