This open-entry open-exit individualized program of study has been extremely beneficial in meeting the pre-college educational needs of the region. Classes are held in Kotzebue four nights a week and cover all five GED subject areas. The teachers are available during the daytime as well as scheduled class time and study sessions. The teachers in Kotzebue are Kathy Baldwin. Vangi Dahl, and Jackie Lawton, and the teacher in the village of Deering is Bonnie Snyder-Jones.

In Deering three students have

recently received their Diplomas and there are two students still studying. This program has been well received. The program in Kotzebue has 33 students currently registered (Spring '80 Semester) and four students have received Diplomas this semester. All GED testing for the NANA Region is done by Chukchi Community the Regional Testing Center.

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
