

# RDC issues call for papers for conference

The Resource Development Council for Alaska Inc. has issued a call for papers in connection with its upcoming conference April 2-4.

The papers will be made available to economic development professionals speaking at the conference and will be reprinted in the conference proceedings.

The questions are:

- What, in your opinion, are the

three most significant opportunities available to Alaska or your community for economic growth and diversification?

- What actions should be taken to realize these opportunities?

- What should be the role of government, the private sector and academic institutions in relation to these actions and opportunities?

- If implementation funding is needed, how should revenues be raised? Respondents may answer any or all of the questions in their submissions.
