

# Arts Council to consider grant requests

The October meeting of the Alaska State Council on the Arts will be held in Fairbanks from Oct. 27 through Oct. 31. The meeting, which is open to the public, will be held at the Fairbanks-North Star Borough Public Library.

Members of the 11-member Council will consider applications for funding from non-profit arts organizations throughout the state, as well as applications from 131 individual artists who have applied for funding under the state's Individual Artist's Assistance Program. In addition to decisions regarding funding, the Council will discuss policy and long-range planning needs.

A special meeting has been added on Oct. 28 to allow representatives from Fairbanks-based arts organizations to ask questions of Council members. This meeting will be one of a series of similar meetings which will culminate in a state-wide conference of arts organizations scheduled to take place in April of 1982.
