## workshop scheduled

Schools, Native corporations, and other agencies that offer vocational education programs in Southeast Alaska have been invited to send staff members to a workshop on how to comply with federal Office of Civil Rights (OCR) guidelines.

The session is scheduled for Jan. 27 in the Officers Club of the Coast Guard Building in Juneau. There is no charge.

The workshop will be conducted by the Department of Education Office of Adult and Vocational Education and will cover such topics as why reviews are scheduled, what areas are reviewed, kinds of documentation required, and kinds of assistance available to help assure compliance.

Federal OCR legislation deals with such issues as enrollment of males and females in traditional programs, accessibility of facilities to handicapped people, counseling techniques used to deal with people of limited English speaking ability and the proportion of minorities in vocational education classrooms.
