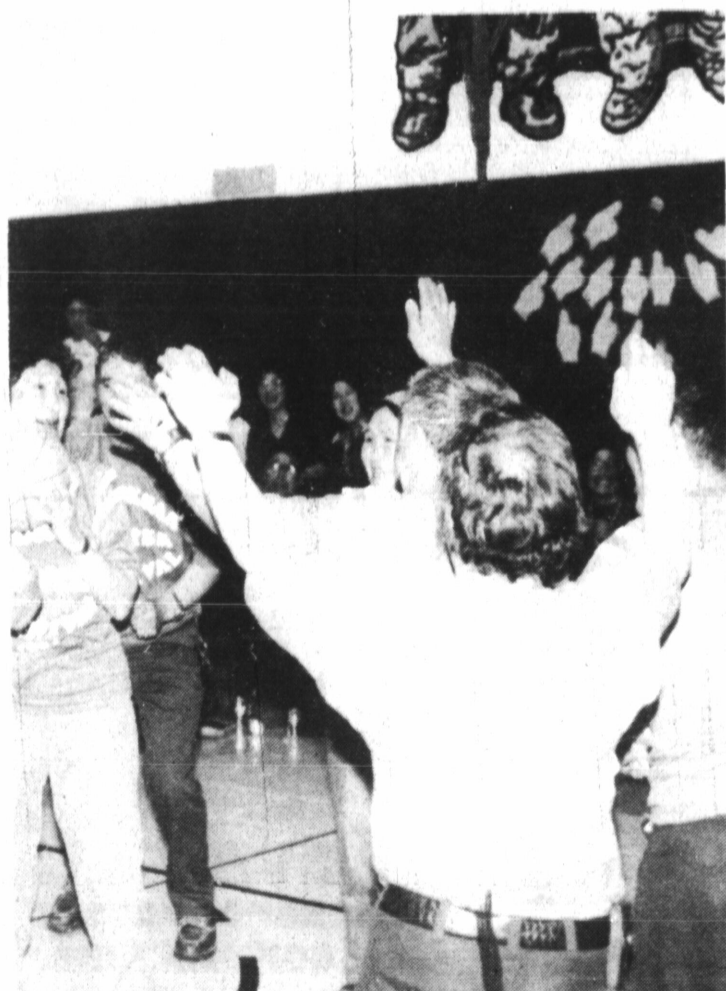


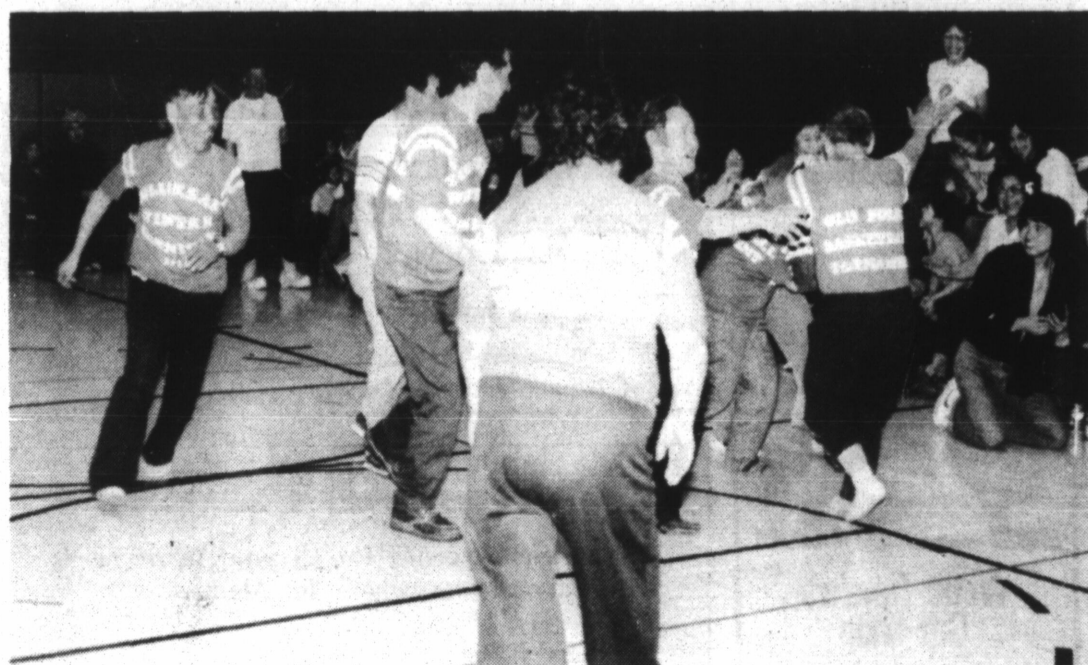
Winter Carnival means Parents' Basketball
