

WEIO set for Aug. 1,2,3,4

The 1984 World Eskimo Indian Olympics will be held on the first four days of August at the Big Dipper Ice skating Rink in Fairbanks, according to WEIO chairman Mike Irwin. The decision to move to the rink was forced by the University of Fairbanks which

will be resurfacing the gymnasium floor at the Patty Gymnasium this summer.

Irwin said the Big Dipper holds 2,500 people and has very modern lighting, concession stands and air ventilation system.

One problem with the faci-

lity is that the WEIO will have to raise \$30,000 to put in a floor to accomodate the athletes because there is only ice on the floor now.

That amount is over the \$75,000 that the WEIO has to raise to send 43 athletes and eskimo dancers to the World Olympics in Los Angeles this summer.
