JUNEAU — The state has awarded a \$598,874 contract for grading, drainage and construction work on 1.1 miles of the Nome-Taylor Highway between Dexter and Banner about 12 miles northeast of Nome, Governor William A. Egan said today.

The project, awarded to B & R. Tug and Barge Inc. of Seattle includes construction of a 180-foot bridge across the Nome River. The work is to be completed in 276 calendar days.
