

# Pipeline

Frank Feeman, Vice President of Alaska Airlines, will give a speech on behalf of the Alaska Pipeline Education Committee to the Bnai B'rith National Convention in Chicago, June 26.

The National Jewish organization will hear Feeman explain the need for immediate construction of the Alaska Pipeline.

He will be speaking to approximately 350 men who represent Bnai B'rith Chapters across the country.

"They are interested in the facts surrounding the need for energy and sources that may be available here in the United States," Feeman commented.

In his talk, Feeman will point out that petroleum and by-products are the major import the U.S. now has, and this year's imports are expected to total 4.3 billion dollars.

He may travel to Chicago with Alaska Senator Ted Stevens, if the Senator's schedule permits, and if the Jackson Bill, which provides new right of way legislation, does not come to the floor that day.
