If voters approve organization into a Coastal Resource Service Area, a second election will be held 60 to 90 days after certification of the Organization Election to elect seven members to the Coastal Resource Board. Nominating petition information, filing deadlines, date of the second election, and other information will be set out following the Organization Election. If organization is disapproved, an election for board members will not be held.

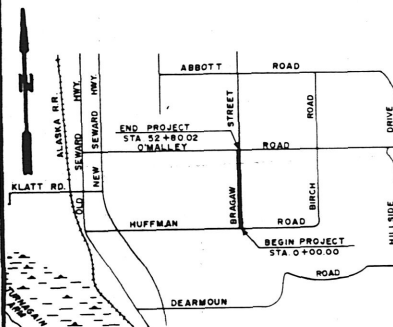
