Individual treatment planning
is the cornerstone of the
Fairbanks Native Association'
Comprehensive Alcoholism
Program (CAP).
Rather than make participants
fill a predetermined mold, the
program's philosophy emphasizes
individual needs as guidelines for
each person's treatment program.
The programs rely heavily on the
two most effective forms of
alcoholism treatment
Alcoholics Anonymous and
psychotherapy.
Entrants to the program must

Entrants to the program must be sober for at least 24 hours before they arrive. "This is not a sleep off center," states Karen


Coady, treatment coordinator.

Most who come are referred by a variety of agencies, including the courts, Division of Corrections, Police, BIA, hospitals and clinics. They are interviewed to determine their suitability for the programs.

According to Coady, the participants must want to be helped to be in CAP. As she put it, "they choose to be here — they're not in jail." After an initial orientation period, the participant decides whether to remain in for treatment, or to drop out of the program.

If the decision is made to continue, an individual program is outlined, and a contract is drawn up between the individual, his counsellor, and the treatment coordinator. This is an agreement between CAP and the participant which covers conduct, repayment, participation, and personal objectives.

The six week "core" program is

the next step. This program consists of classes, films, discussion groups, group and individual counselling, therapy, and other activities, mostly related to aspects of alcoholism and its treatment. Participants are not allowed to have outside jobs. not allowed to have outside jobs

during the core period.

After the core period, participants who choose participants who choose to may continue living at the CAP facility for a period of time referred to as "transitional living." This is arranged for those who are employed, in training, or in an educational program.

An important part of CAP is "Cost recovery." This is the manner in which participants.

"Cost recovery." This is the manner in which participants repay the program for services provided — either by working at the CAP facility or for the city

doing various jobs according to his ability, or if he has a job, by giving a part of his paycheck to

the program.

Coady emphasizes the fact that this is "mutual help" beneficial to participants as well as the participants as




