thority vested by AS 14.07.060, proposed to amend regulation 7 Title 4 of the Alaska Administrative Code to implement AS 14.07.070(c) and AS 14.07.020(1) and (2) as follows:

1. A CAC 05.070 is amended by making more specific the obligations of school districts to participate in the planning and evaluation of local school projects and also making more specific the requirements of the planning and evaluation documents and process.
2. A CAC 12. is amended by requiring that school district superintendents to possess an administrative certificate with an endorsement as superintendent.
