

Lloyd Sutton Named Health Coordinator

Lloyd Sutton was recently named health coordinator for the Alaska Federation of Natives

under the Office of Equal Opportunity Bethel Healthright Project.

Sutton, a Tlingit Indian from Sitka, is also on the board of directors of the program planning and evaluation committee of the area office for the U.S. Public Health Service, Indian Health Service, Alaska Native Health Service.

He was appointed by Governor Walter Hickel in 1968 to a one year term on the State Comprehensive Health Advisory Council and has since been re-appointed by Governor Miller for another term of three years.

Pending the final signature of Robert Finch, Secretary of Health Education and Welfare, Sutton will also serve on the Advisory Committee to Indian Health Service in Washington, D.C.
