The statute passed by the legislature in 1986 allowing an ELECTION BY MAIL did not go into effect until January 1, 1987. Therefore, the November 24, 1986 RUN-OFF Election conducted by mail has been voided and a new RUN-OFF Election has been ordered. Under AS 15.20.800 now in effect, the new election to be held on April 28th, 1987, will be conducted by mail.

VOTERS WILL VOTE BY MAIL. THERE WILL BE NO POLLING PLACE FOR REGULAR IN PERSON VOTING ON ELECTION DAY

1. WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO VOTE? Any registered voter who resides in the Kuspuks School District.

2. HOW DOES A VOTER GET A BALLOT? The Division of Elections mailed ballot to each eligible voter at their mailing address listed on their registration record.

BALLOTS WERE MAILED THE WEEK OF APRIL 1, 1987.

3. HOW DO I VOTE MY BALLOT? Follow the instructions sent with your ballot. The instructions remind you to:

- MARK YOUR CANDIDATE CHOICE ON YOUR BALLOT
- COMPLETE AND SIGN THE BALLOT ENVELOPE
- HAVE YOUR SIGNATURE WITNESSED
- MAIL YOUR VOTED BALLOT BACK TO THE ELECTION SUPERVISOR IN THE POSTAGE PAID RETURN ENVELOPE PROVIDED.

4. WHEN DO I HAVE TO MAIL MY VOTED BALLOT BACK? You may vote and return your ballot at any time after you receive it, BUT NO LATER THAN APRIL 28, 1987. If your ballot is postmarked by the post office, it must be postmarked not later than April 28.

5. WHAT IF I DON'T GET A BALLOT, I MISPLACE IT, OR NEED ASSISTANCE? Election Officials will be available in each precinct if you need a ballot, or assistance in marking your ballot or completing your return envelope. The Election Official will also have ballots on hand if you need to vote ABSENTEE IN PERSON.

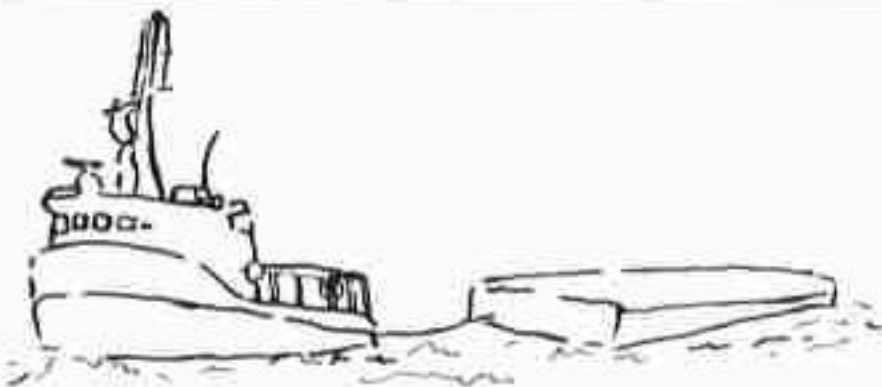
