

# ASCAP Looking For Coordinator For So. Central

The Alaska State Community Action Program, Inc., is looking for a new South-central Regional Coordinator to fill the position left vacant by newly elected Alaska Federation of Natives president Emil Notti.

Notti left the organization this month to travel to Washington with State Representative Willie Hensley to represent the Native people in the land claims talks.

Carried now on leave without pay, Notti is taking his position as AFN president and ASCAP is searching for a replacement.

"The job is extremely important," says ASCAP executive director Flore Lekanof. "The coordinator supervises all OEO activities

in the Southcentral Region. He must be able to coordinate the efforts of many people, and he has to be capable of effective dealings with the federal agencies and with CEO headquarters."
