

CHIEFS MEETING SLATED IN FAIRBANKS MAR. 16-18

The annual Tanana Chiefs Meeting held in the past two years in Tanana, has been updated and it will be held in Fairbanks on March 16-17-18 in the Eagle's Hall.

The meeting will take place during the North American Championship dog races here in Fairbanks.

According to Richard Frank, who is acting as the program director for the meet, education, and probably Rampart Dam, will be discussed among other subjects.

Invitations have been sent out to Native leaders in the Interior but until today, it was not certain how many of them will attend.

A huge potlatch is planned on the evening of March 18 and it will be held in the Eagle's Hall.

"We are planning a real good show to put on that evening," said Richard Frank.
