JUNEAU The state has awarded a \$725,091 contract to A&G Construction Co. of Anchorage for realignment work on 1-¼ miles of the Anchorage-Fairbanks Highway, and a \$293,180 contract to Hermon Brothers Construction Co. of Palmer for construction of a 20-foot roadway between the Kuskokwim River villages of Upper Kalskag and Lower Kalskag, Governor William A. Egan said.

The governor said another state contract for \$128,500, awarded by the Department of Public Works to Summers Construction Co. of Anchorage, provides for a 2,210 square foot addition to the elementary school at Kenny Lake.

It is scheduled for completion in August.
