HELP WANTED

The Interim Council on Domestic Violence and Sexual Assault is recruiting for filling the position of Executive Director for the permanent Council by November 15, 1981. This position, located in Juneau, will provide primary administrative, professional and coordinative direction in identifying issues, trends, solutions for violence in the state, especially domestic violence and sexual assault. The director will administer, coordinate, and recommend policies and priorities to the Council, implement the policies determined by the Council, monitor over 20 statewide programs funded by the Council, recruit, employ and supervise a professional and support staff. The annual budget for this effort is in excess of \$5 million dollars.

The Director must have knowledge of budgetary and fiscal controls, state fiscal accounting and budget process and procedures, including grants and contracts, knowledge of organization and management principles, group process and human behavior, including women's issues, criminal justice, human resource services and dynamics of domestic violence and sexual assault. It requires 5 years of professional administrative experience and demonstrated ability in program development, community organization and managerial and fiscal experience. Experience either serving on a Board or having been a staff person for a Board is desirable. The Council is an Equal Opportunity Employer.
