

Young wins AIPRC appointment

Alaska's lone Congressman, Don Young, has been selected to fill a vacancy on the American Indian Policy Review Commission.

Young helped sponsor legislation creating the commission in 1974. Its purpose is to conduct a comprehensive study of the unique and historical relationship between the U. S.

Government and American Indians and Alaska Natives.

Young replaces Rep. Sam Steiger (R-Arizona) who lost his bid for re-election in November.

The Commission is expected to send recommendations to Congress later this year which may have far-reaching impact on Native people.
